In this chorister's prayer from the Christian tradition, we aspire to align our hearts and actions with what we express through speech and song.

But what is it that we are giving expression to in our lives through music? Where does sound come from, what sustains it and where does it go to? What limits our musical potential and can we overcome this?

In this course we will attempt to address some of these fundamental questions through performing, composing and listening. We will explore the writing of great philosophers and theologians from Eastern and Western traditions.

The course will include lectures and workshops by musicians and guest speakers, alongside opportunities for singing, instrumental performance, composition and solo performance.



Information about attending

To attend, you need to have a love of music and enjoy singing. The ability to sight-read musical notation at any standard will be helpful, but this is not essential.

This week is open to any members of the School from around the world who meditate and have been to at least one philosophy residential prior to attending. That being said, anybody is welcome to apply to attend (via an informal discussion with Adrian Green) and there is a possibility of exceptions being made where applicants understand and respect the ethos and values of the School.

Students attending should arrive in good time for the first meeting which will start promptly at 4pm on Saturday the 25th of July. Refreshments will be available from 3pm. Departure will be at 9am on Saturday the 1st of August.
